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**JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)**

The prayer is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in Case FIR No.441 dated 14.12.2014, under Section 394 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Udyog Vihar, Gurgaon.

The complainant-Yogesh Kumar had taken a journey on 14.12.2014 at 2:00 AM by boarding a passenger Innova Car. The petitioner along with two other co-accused were fellow travellers, who gave beatings to the complainant and robbed him of cash and ATM Cards including the passwords. Thereafter, the petitioner along with his co-accused have withdrawn money by using the said ATM Card. The footing of the petitioner in the CCTV at the ATM Centre has come in evidence.

It is contended that the offence is triable by the Magistrate and the petitioner has already undergone more than one year and the evidence of the prosecution is yet to conclude.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Manoj Kumar, submits that 04 out of 17 prosecution witnesses have already been examined. He further assures the Court that all steps would be taken to conclude the prosecution evidence at the earliest.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

It is hoped that the prosecution would expedite the adducing of its evidence.
