Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajwant Singh, Police Station, Rangar Nangal submits that in compliance of orders dated 26.10.2016 of this Court the petitioner has since joined the investigation and that nothing is to be recovered from him and has not opposed the grant of bail to the petitioner.

Though, the bail application is opposed by the learned counsel for the complainant on the ground that one of the injury attributed to the petitioner is covered under Section 326 IPC but keeping in view that the petitioner has already joined the investigations and that no case for his
