This petition has been filed for quashing of order dated 22.04.2016 declaring him as proclaimed offender in Complaint Case No.537/2005 titled as ***Hindu Cooperative Bank vs. Janardhan*** Prakash, by the Court of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Pathankot.

Learned counsel argues that actually three cases were filed

on the same date by the respondent and the petitioner received

summoned only in one case. He was regularly appearing in that case and there was no reason for him to not appear in other cases if he had known about the same. He further states that the petitioner is ready to face trial in the other cases as well.

In my opinion, it would be appropriate if the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court and moves an application for regular bail. In case the assertion regarding the appearance in other case is found to be correct the application for regular bail be decided on the same day.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
