The prayer in this present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr. P.C is for quashing of FIR No. 152 dated 11.09.2015 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 295/298/323/34 of IPC at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Amritsar alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (*Annexure P-2*).

Report of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar has been received wherein it has been reported that the statements of the complainant and accused have been recorded and compromise has been effected between the parties. It has also been reported that the complainant has no objection if the present FIR registered against the petitioners is quashed. It is

further reported that the said compromise is voluntary and is without any coercion, pressure or undue influence.

Since, the parties have amicably settled their dispute, therefore, FIR No. 152 dated 11.09.2015 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 295/298/323/34 of IPC at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Amritsar stand quashed alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (*Annexure P-2*).
