This petition under Section 482 of the Criminal Procedure Code has been filed for quashing of FIR No.95 dated 23.08.2012 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 323, 324 and 325 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') at Police Station Mehtiana, District Hoshiarpur on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the matter has been compromised with the petitioner. The quashing of FIR has been sought by one of the accused.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

This Court is of the opinion that partial quashing of FIR cannot be allowed. No case for quashing the FIR on the basis of compromise is made out.

However, in view of the fact that other co-accused have been

acquitted of the charges and keeping in view the compromise, it is ordered that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within 10 days from today, the bail application will be decided expeditiously.
