Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.577 dated 28.09.2016 under Sections 18C of Drugs & Cosmetics Act and Section 21C and 22C of Narcotic Drugs & Phychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station City Fatehabad, District Fatehabad.

This Court vide order dated 08.11.2016 has granted ad-interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 08.11.2016, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Mukhtiar Singh has stated that in terms of above order, petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 08.11.2016 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
