Heard learned counsel for the rival parties and perused the order dated 05.02.2016 made by this Court granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the complainant makes a statement that the petitioner indulged in cheating her and also assaulting on her after the grant of bail by this Court for which a complaint has also been registered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that his wife as well as himself are closely connected with L.I.C. The petitioner would continue to repay back the installment for loan amount and would not throw any liability on his wife. Petitioner shall not harass the complainant-wife.

In that view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, I am inclined to make the interim order dated 05.02.2016 absolute.

In that view of the matter, the interim order dated 05.02.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. The petitioner would continue to repay the installments for loan and would not throw any liability on the wife. The petitioner shall not harass the complainant-wife.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
