Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

The petition is for quashing of FIR No.16 dated 12.2.2008, registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC, at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur, along with all consequential proceedings.

Report of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Mukerian received. Learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of the complainant as well as the accused. The learned Magistrate has reported that the parties have effected compromise between themselves which is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Since the parties have compromised, therefore, FIR No.16 dated 12.2.2008, registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC, at Police Station Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur, along with consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
