Petitioner, as member of unlawful assembly, is alleged to have assaulted the nephew of the complainant.

The petitioner is not attributed any injury. Three persons named in the FIR had been arrested and granted concession of regular bail.

Since the petitioner has already joined the investigation pursuant to the interim order passed by this Court, it does not appear to be a case where custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required.

The petition is allowed. Interim order dated 26.10.2016 is hereby made absolute subject to all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
