**HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)**

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.5 and further issuance of a direction to respondent No.5 and his subordinate staff not to harass and humiliate the petitioners at the instance of respondent No.6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that respondent No.6 Dinesh Midha is brother-in-law (Sadhu) of petitioner No.2 Sunil Verma and there is a family dispute between them. She further states that in order to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, the petitioner No.2 has already submitted a representation dated 22.7.2016 (Annexure P-4) to the respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh. The petitioner No.3

Ramesh Kumar has also submitted a similar representation on 22.7.2016, Annexure P-5 (which has wrongly been typed as Annexure P-2). She further states that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to look into the contents of said representations.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1, 3 and 5 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Amit Kumar Goyal, APP, U.T., Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to look into the contents of aforementioned representations dated 22.7.2016 and to act in accordance with law.
