Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in complaint case No.10/16 dated 08.02.2010, under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

Learned counsel has argued that the petitioner was communicated the date as 19.05.2016 whereas it was actually 17.05.2016 and because of this confusion she did not appear. Further he states that the petitioner had no intention of misusing the bail granted by the Court and undertakes that she would not misuse the concession of bail in the future and that she is also ready to pay some costs.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, I deem

it appropriate to allow the petition. Ordered accordingly.

Let the petitioner appear before the trial Court on the date fixed which is stated to be 09.11.2016 and pay an amount of Rs.10,000/- as costs to the complainant-respondent No.2. On her appearance the trial Court shall release her on bail to its satisfaction subject to the payment of the said costs.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
