Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Satwant Kaur in case FIR No.142 dated 11.11.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 304 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Raja Sansi, District Amritsar.

The petitioner is a Midwife, who has while conducting the delivery of the deceased-Manpreet Kaur, is alleged to have caused her death. The baby boy delivered, however, is healthy and safe and is in the custody of the co-accused/non applicant/mother-in-law of the deceased.

It is contended that mother-in-law of the deceased has since

been granted anticipatory bail.

It is submitted that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Lakhwinder Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 08th of February, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
