Petitioner has been in custody with effect from 08.03.2016 in a case registered at the instance of Sub Inspector Kewal Krishan to the effect that a secret information had been received that the petitioner along with four others, armed with deadly weapons, were making preparations to commit dacoity at different places under the gang leadership of Parvinder Singh. Recovery of stolen bikes and live cartridges were allegedly effected from the petitioner.

Since recovery has already been effected, the liability of the petitioner, on the basis of the allegations, appears to be a debatable issue. Petitioner has been reported to be involved in a few other criminal cases.

However, taking into consideration the nature of allegations against the petitioner i.e. for having made preparation to commit

dacoity, he can be granted the concession of bail.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
