Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to transfer the investigation of case FIR No.117 dated 28.9.2015 under Sections 279, 427 and 304-A IPC registered at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though the FIR in question was registered on 28.9.2015, but no progress has taken place in the case. He further states that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 23.11.2015 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.4 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sangrur, but still the matter remained standstill.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab

accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.4 to look into the contents of representation dated 23.11.2015 (Annexure P-5) and to act in accordance with law. Since the FIR was registered in the year 2015, it is expected that the matter would be expedited preferably within a period of six months from today.
