Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos. 6 to 11.

At the very outset, the learned counsel states that inadvertently the name of respondent No.2 has wrongly been mentioned

as Superintendent of Police, Fazilka instead of Senior Superintendent of

Police, Fazilka in the memo of parties as well as in the representation (Annexure P-4) and prays that the same may be corrected.

Allowed as prayed for.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of the Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 26.01.1998 whereas petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of the Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 06.02.1998. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka (Annexure P-4) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-4).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
