At the asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Paul, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

Though, by virtue of the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. petitioner has sought quashing of impugned order dated 16.08.2016 (Annexure P-3) vide which he has been declared proclaimed offender in criminal complaint No.74/1 of 2010 dated 09.03.2010 (Annexure P-1), yet he feels satisfied in case a direction is given to the petitioner to surrender/appear before the trial court and an application filed by him for grant of bail be decided within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to petitioner to appear/surrender before the trial court and apply for bail, which shall be dealt with and disposed of by the trial court within a period of three working

days. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to file a fresh petition for quashing of the complaint or the order on the basis of the compromise, if he so desires.
