Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.34 dated 21.05.2015, registered under Sections 406/498-A IPC, Women Police Station, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that compromise has been effected between the parties before the Mediation Centre. Report of the Mediation Centre has also been received and as per the terms of the compromise the petitioner had to get a plot measuring 200 Sq. Yds. transfer in the name of his son Parth and deposit a sum of Rs.5 lacs in the shape of fixed deposit in the name of Parth. It is stated that both the conditions have been fulfilled.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The order dated 03.11.2015 is made absolute and the petitioner is directed to be released on anticipatory bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate.
