Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.1 to 4 to submit the report under Section 173 Cr.PC in case FIR No.112 dated 4.4.2015 under Sections 323, 341, 355, 295-A, 148, 149, 506 and 356 IPC registered at Police Station Phagwara City, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that earlier, the petitioner had also approached this Court by way of ***CRM-M-13011 of 2015*** and this Court vide order dated 24.4.2015 had passed the following order:

“Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to look into the representation (Annexure P5), stated to have been submitted by the petitioner on 13.4.2015.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that despite the FIR having been registered on 4.4.2015 and the direction issued by this Court vide order dated 24.4.2015, investigation in the case has not been completed by the police. He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondents to expedite the investigation.

Notice of motion.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Sultan Singh Gill, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.1 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to expedite the investigation in the FIR in question and to complete the same preferably within a period of six months from today.
