Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

Petition is for quashing of FIR No.172 dated 24.7.2014 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Amritsar City.

Learned Counsel for the complainant-respondent No.2 states that the entire outstanding amount has been paid and the loan has been recovered, therefore, they have issued no objection certificate, copy of which is Annexure P-2. Learned Counsel for the complainant-respondent/Bank further states that they have no objection if the present FIR is quashed.

In view of no objection by the Bank, FIR No.172 dated 24.7.2014 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Amritsar City, along with all consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is allowed accordingly.
