JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Jagdish Singh in case FIR No.123 dated 28.12.2015, under Sections 307, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and under Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered with Police Station Hathur, Distt. Ludhiana (**Annexure P-1**).

It was contended that five of the co-accused including main accused who had inflicted injuries and fired shots have since been arrested. Further contends that no specific role has been attributed to the petitioner except vague allegations. Further it was submitted that the petitioner is a student of B.A. 1st year.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Bahadur Singh, concedes that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 08.02.2016, is made absolute.
