Prayer in this petition under Section 439, Criminal Procedure Code, on behalf of accused/petitioner-Avtar Singh is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 45/2015, dated 28.02.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 419, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 65/66/66-A, Information Technology Act, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

Complainant-Tara Singh Sallan is an NRI and alleged to have been cheated of a sum of Rs. 1,25,00,000/- (rupees one crore twenty five lacs only) by the accused party comprising of the present accused/petitioner-Avtar Singh and his co-accused/son-Jagdeep Singh and one Amandeep Singh, on the pretext of securing a Franchise of KFC for outlet at Hoshiarpur.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 12.12.2015.

Learned counsel for the complainant points out that even the terms and conditions of the compromise for payment of half the amount was not complied with by the accused party.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Paramjit Singh, submits that two other co-accused persons including the son of the present petitioner have been declared proclaimed offender.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
