The petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Raj Singh alleging that he has been duped of a sum of Rs.1 crore by co-accused Chand Singh and Krishan, who hatched a criminal conspiracy by presenting impersonators/ non-applicant Subeg Singh and Sukha Singh as original owners of land and executed a forged and fabricated agreement of sale in favour of the complainant, whereas the original owners Rajpal and Balbir had never executed any agreement.

Petitioner does not appear to have been named in the FIR as he has been named in the disclosure statement of the co-accused.

Taking into consideration the period of detention suffered by the petitioner that is w.e.f. 26.08.2016, co-accused of the petitioner having been granted concession of bail by this Court, petitioner can also be granted the same relief.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
