JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the event of arrest in FIR No.144 dated 02.08.2015, under Sections 323, 354, 452, 120-B (wrongly mentioned as 552) of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Civil Line, Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, have joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned DAG Punjab for the respondent-State, on instructions from ASI Rajwinder Singh, submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for the custodial interrogation. In fact, a cancellation report is in the process of being prepared.

In view of the facts that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 04.11.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
