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A. B. CHAUDHARI, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.103 dated 14.06.2015 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Canal Colony Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner. He makes statement that the parties namely the complainant and the accused person have arrived at a compromise and a Panchayati compromise (Annexure P-2) has been recorded.

Learned State counsel submits that there is no other case pending against the accused and the matter has been compromised.

I have seen the compromise so also the offences in question. In my opinion, since the parties have compromised mutually vide Annexure P-2, the compounding be allowed in the light of the decision by Hon'ble Supreme

Court in the case of ***Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and another, 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543***. In that view of the matter I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-37755 OF 2015 is allowed.
- (ii) The FIR No.103 dated 14.06.2015 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Canal Colony Bathinda, District Bathinda, is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
