Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.520 dated 4.10.2016 under Sections 5/13(2), 17 of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015 as well as Section 11 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 registered at Police Station Punhana, District Mewat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no identification parade of the petitioner was conducted by the police. He further contends that neither there is any evidence nor any other case is pending against the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The allegation made in the FIR is that the police party on the basis of secret information had found that a vehicle was intercepted. On checking, it was found that ropes and one plastic bag of while colour

containing two iron daggers, one iron axe and one wooden cardboard were lying in the said vehicle. The police party also found six weak and feeble cows in the field at a distance of about 30 feet from the truck, which were tied by ropes in cruel manner.

The allegations levelled against the petitioner are serious in nature. Therefore, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
