The allegations against the petitioner is that in his school premises, the candidates had been shown the leaked papers.

Without expression of any opinion, regarding the culpability of the petitioner, it is sufficient to observe that the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 13.09.2016 and the investigation is still in progress.

Taking into consideration the role attributed to the petitioner and the period of detention suffered by him, he can be granted the concession of bail.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety

bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the additional conditions that the petitioner will not indulge himself in the similar activities during the entire period of trial and will not leave India without the permission of the Court.
