Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0039 dated 10.02.2016 under Sections 18 & 19 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Ambala City, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case, whereas learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Jasbir Singh, submits that the petitioner and her whole family members are indulged under NDPS cases and as many as 4 cases under NDPS Act have been registered against her husband-Manjeet Singh @ Bhola whereas 5 cases are registered against her father-in-law, namely, Niranjana Singh.

Heard, learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the nature of allegation, no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed.
