FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations against the petitioners in this anticipatory bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. are that on 21.05.2016 the petitioner along with his co-accused had an altercation with the opposite party consisting of William Masih, Mohabbat Masih, Yunus Masih, Happy Masih and Sukha Masih resulting in injuries to both the sides.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners have been attributed only simple injuries on the non-vital part and that it is a case of version and cross-version in which the petitioner's side too have received injuries and, thus, is a debatable issue as to which of the party was at fault and that the similarly placed co-accused have been

granted similar relief by this Court.

In view thereof and keeping in view the principle of parity, the present application is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioners be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Investigating Officer and that they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
