Present petition has been filed praying for the directions for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners, who have entered into matrimony against the wishes of their parents.

As per office report, notices could not be issued to respondents No. 4 and 5, as nobody has come forward to collect the dasti summons. Even, ordinary notices could not be issued to them due to non-filing of process fee.

However, learned State counsel has produced the statement of petitioner No.1-Gagandeep Kaur wife of Navneet Singh (petitioner No.2) to the effect that they do not require any police protection, as their family members have agreed to the matrimonial alliance.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the validity of marriage and taking into consideration the statement suffered by petitioner

No.1, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
