The prayer in this present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr. P.C is for quashing of FIR No. 151 dated 19.12.2014 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 323/498A/406/506/120B at Police Station Sector 19, Panchkula alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of statements (*Annexure P-3 and P-5*) recorded in divorce petition.

Report of the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division)-cum-Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Panchkula has been received wherein it has been reported that the statements of the complainant and accused have been recorded and compromise has been effected between the parties. It is further reported that the said compromise is voluntary and is without any coercion, pressure or undue influence.

It comes out that basically it was a matrimonial dispute which is stated to have been amicably settled. Parties have got divorce by mutual consent.

In view of the above, FIR No. 151 dated 19.12.2014 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 323/498A/406/506/120B at Police Station Sector 19, Panchkula alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom stand quashed.

Hence, the present petition stands allowed.
