Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.1 to 4 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.217 dated 25.12.2015 under Section 279 and 304-A IPC registered at Police Station Samana, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that since the fair investigation was not being conducted, the petitioner had submitted a representation (Annexure P-3) which is undated. She further states that the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala is directed to look into the contents of said representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Sultan Singh Gill, DAG, Punjab

accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-3) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law. It is made clear that in case no such representation has been made by the petitioner in the office of respondent No.2 i.e. Deputy Superintendent of Police, Samana, it would not be incumbent upon the respondent No.3 to look into the contents of said representation.
