The petition has been filed seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to register a criminal complaint against respondent No.4 as per the narration of the events made out in the complaint Annexure P-1.

On notice, reply has been filed stating that after receiving complaint Annexure P-1, enquiry was conducted by the then ACP(North) and ACP (Central) Ludhiana wherein it is revealed that father of respondent No.4 had given Rs.3 lacs to the petitioner and her husband for start of the spare parts business. When he started demanding money back, her husband started threatening the father of respondent No.4. On 3.10.2012, father of respondent No.4 had made an application to SHO P.S.Sultanwind, District Amritsar against the petitioner and husband of respondent No.4. FIR No.216 dated 13.9.2013 under Sections 420,120-B IPC Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar City was registered against the petitioner and her husband for not returning the amount of Rs.3 lacs. Thereafter, the report

Annexure P-3 has been placed on record whereby ACP Centre Ludhiana had thorough investigation.

Counsel for the State has informed that FIR No.88 dated 1.7.2016 under Sections 376, 506, 511 IPC at P.S.Divn No.2 Ludhiana has now been registered against respondent No.4.

No further orders are required to be passed.
