Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.286 dated 08.05.2015, under Sections 395, 397, 449, 212 IPC and 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station, Sadar Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was arrested on 15.06.2015 on the disclosure statement made by one of the co-accused and that in the trial, charges have been framed but no PW has been examined.
