The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.48 dated 01.04.2015, under Section 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran.

Allegations against the present petitioner as also other co-accused are with respect to having duped the complainant as also her husband of a sum of Rs.3,70,000/- on the assurance that such amount of money would be doubled.

Perusal of the order dated 06.06.2015 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran would reveal that the accused including the present petitioner even attempted a compromise but the same did not fructify.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner has very fairly brought to the notice of this Court that even an affidavit of the complainant had been filed before the Suvidha Centre and as per which a sum of Rs.2,10,000/- had been returned by all the accused collectively out of the alleged total amount of Rs.3,70,000/-. This would itself indicate that the allegations made by the

complainant are not without justification.

This Court does not found any infirmity in the order dated 06.06.2015 declining the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The present petition is accordingly dismissed.
