The petitioner is facing trial in FIR No.16, dated 18.02.2016, under Sections 15/25/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

The petitioner was on regular bail but having not appeared before the trial court on 14.10.2016, his bail was ordered to be cancelled and his bail bonds forfeited to the State. Non-bailable warrants were issued for his arrest.

Impugning the above action, the present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

On 27.10.2016, while issuing notice of motion this Court had issued an interim direction that the petitioner will put in appearance before the trial court within a period of seven days and in case of his doing so, he will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the said court.

Counsel for the petitioner has produced a certified copy of order dated 04.11.2016, passed by the Special Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib, as per which, in terms of the orders of this Court dated 27.10.2016, the petitioner surrendered and furnished bail bonds in the sum of Rs.1 lac with two sureties of like amount. His bail bonds were accepted. A certified copy of the order of the trial court dated 04.11.2016 is ordered to be taken on record as Annexure 'X'.

In view of the above, while allowing the present petition, the order dated 14.10.2016, passed by the trial court is set aside and order dated 27.10.2016 granting the ad-interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
