By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.237, dated 16.07.2015, registered under Sections 419, 420, 464, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar.

On 05.11.2015, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegations against the petitioner are at par with Harish Kumar, who has approached this Court by way of filing Criminal Misc. No.M-28851 of 2015, wherein, after issuing notice of motion, the case is fixed for hearing on 26.11.2015.

Notice of motion for 26.11.2015.

To be heard along with Criminal Misc. No.M-28851 of 2015.

Interim order in the same terms as in Criminal Misc. No.M 28851 of 2015.”

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 05.11.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 05.11.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
