The allegation against the petitioner is that of having snatched the purse of the complainant Dilpreet Kaur while she was riding on the rickshaw. The case of the prosecution rests upon circumstantial evidence besides the statement of Dilpreet Kaur. Statement of Dilpreet Kaur has already been recorded.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a direction that trial will be concluded within a period of four months from the next date of hearing as only three witnesses out of seven remain to be examined. In case the trial is not concluded within a period of four months from the next date of hearing, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again for grant of bail.
