Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Parveen Atteri in case FIR No.603 dated 4.8.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 147, 149, 506 and 419 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Counsel for the parties heard at length.

As per the allegations, the petitioner accused Parveen along with 7/8 boys came to the examination centre and abused and threatened the Centre Superintendent and other staff. The reason for such behaviour was that earlier during the day the Assistant Supervisor had apprehended one girl impersonating as Suman Rani i.e. wife of the present accused. The said

impersonator was making effort to appear in the Maths examination on behalf of the said Suman Rani and said impersonator had subsequently escaped from the Centre.

In the light of the allegations, no case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
