This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.0087 dated 27.05.2016 registered under Sections 465, 468, 471, 420 IPC at P.S. Sadar Khanna, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana.

As per the allegations in the FIR the brother of the complainant had obtained an illegal connection in the name of the father by moving an application in his name after his death. The petitioner was insider and had facilitated the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that these are mere allegations. However learned DAG on instructions from ASI Amarjeet has pointed out that PSPCL, the employer of the petitioner had initiated a domestic enquiry and from that enquiry it was found that the petitioner had hidden the original record and admitted his guilt. The petitioner was suspended and recommendation was made to lodge an FIR against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that what has come out are mere allegations which cannot be accepted.

I am not in a position to agree with the learned counsel for the petitioner and dismiss this petition.
