JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Bhagirath, Kiran Pal, Manoj, Pawan, Kailash, Rajnish, Maru @ Rohtash and Vikram in case FIR No.142 dated 26.09.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 148, 149, 323 and 506 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Satnali, District Mahendergarh.

Learned Counsel contents that it is a case of version and cross version; the injured of the present case had received the simple injuries which is apparent from the offences for which the petitioners have been booked; Kiran Pal-petitioner no.2 had received grievous injuries on his skull while the other injured from the petitioner-side had received numerous

injuries in the same incident in which the informant alleged to have received injuries; the applicability of Section 149 IPC would be a moot point during trial; and except Sections 148 and 506 IPC, all other offences for which the petitioner have been booked are bailable.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Ram Bhagat submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 5th of November, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
