By this petition the petitioners have sought directions to the official respondents to not harass them at the instance of respondent No.5 in connection with property regarding which civil suits are already pending.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in this connection the petitioners have also moved a representation dated

22.10.2016 (Annexure P-5) and at this stage they would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna to look into the matter and take appropriate action on their representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
