Report dated 18.02.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar based on the statement of complainant- Jaswinder Singh himself as well as in the capacity of father-cum-holder of power of attorney of Vatanvir Singh, injured who has placed on record copy of the same as well as compromise deed Annexure P/1 and also the statement of the petitioners/accused Jaswant Singh, Kabal Singh, Gurwinder Singh and Raigurinder Singh whereby, Court has shown its satisfaction to the compromise that the same is an outcome of voluntariness without any pressure and undue influence.

Keeping in view that the allegations in which the accused have been hauled up are not serious in nature and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out

the differences between them and to bring about harmony and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012 (4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.153 dated 28.06.2009 under Sections 326 (added later on) 323,324,506,148,149 IPC Police Station, Jandiala, Amritsar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
