Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the respondents No. 2 and 3 have made statement that they do not want to file reply to the application for impleading Ravi Kumar son of Gurmeet Singh and Prince son of Balveer Chand as respondents No.4 and 5 respectively and have no objection if the application is allowed.

In view thereof and keeping in view the fact that the parties have undergone a compromise over this dispute and in the interest of justice, the application stands allowed.

Tarandeep Singh @ Deepu Dargan, Ranjit Singh, Amit Dargan and Iqbal Singh as well as of complainants Parminder Singh @ Deepu and Pawan Kumar it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view the same and the fact that parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not of heinous nature which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052,** FIR No.34 dated 15.04.2015 under Sections 336,451,324,323,148,149 IPC and Sections 25,27,54,59 of Arms Act, Police Station Jalalabad, District Fazilka and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
