Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052, Rapat No. 34 dated 17.04.2015 under Sections 324,323,341,427,379,148,149 IPC registered at Police Station, City Jalalabad in FIR No.34 dated 15.04.2015 under Sections 336,451,324,323,148,149 IPC and Sections 25,27,54,59 of Arms Act, Police Station Jalalabad, District Fazilka and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
