FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 21.04.2016 of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant-Subedar Major Harpal Singh and the accused persons namely Jagir Singh, Balwinder Singh, Rachhpal Singh and Surinder Singh, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, the fact that being a pure money dispute, the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of

the law laid down in "**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**" 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and "**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**" 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.04 dated 14.01.2014 registered at Police Station Division 4, Jalandhar District Jalandhar City under Sections 406, 420 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR *qua* the present petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
