The petitioner got recovered nine bottles of COREX, after having been named by his co-accused, namely Parmod, pursuant to the disclosure statement under Section 27 of the Evidence Act, 1872, while in the custody.

The quantity recovered from the petitioner being, *prima-facie*, non-commercial quantity and the report of the chemical examiner having not been received, without expression of any opinion on merits, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The petitioner

is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Special Judge, Sirsa.
