Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.147 dated 26.2.2011 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 166, 217 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Hisar (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion to respondent No.1 only at this stage.

At the asking of this Court, Ms. Shaveta Sanghi, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Let requisite number of copies of the complete sets of paper book be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Perusal of the record reveals that earlier also, the petitioner has

approached this Court vide ***CRM-M-14321 of 2011*** for the similar relief and the said petition was dismissed as withdrawn on May 11, 2011.

No new case is made out by way of the present petition and, therefore, this Court does not intend to interfere with the same.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR in question was registered on 26.2.2011, but the trial is going at snail's pace.

Taking into consideration the fact that the FIR was registered on 26.2.2011, the trial Court is directed to expedite the trial.
