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**JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)**

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Jaimal Singh in case FIR No.64 dated 23.07.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 295-A, 120-B and 201 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Kiratpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

As per the allegations the petitioner had concealed the items whereupon the co-accused Himmat Singh had vomited near the Guru Granth Sahib in the Gurudwara.

It is contended that the role of the petitioner in the management of the Gurudwara Sahib was only to provide charge regulating the duties of the various *Granthies* and he was not present at the time of alleged vomiting

by the co-accused.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Chiranji Lal submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 25<sup>th</sup> of January, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
