By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought direction to respondent Nos. 2 & 3 to conduct an inquiry in the investigation afresh and further that investigation of the case be handed over to crime branch, IVC or any other specialized agency.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

During the course of arguments, it has been emerged that though a representation dated July 28, 2016 (Annexure P-4) was moved to the Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh, but till date no action is stated to have been taken. Rather, the police is favouring the opposite party.

The instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent Nos.2 & 3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated July 28, 2016 (Annexure P-4) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
