Challenge is to the proclaimed offender order, in view of the prayer clause in Para 8 of the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the compromise (Annexure-P-3) has been entered into between the parties and as such the parties have settled their matter. The statements have been recorded by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Baba Bakala Sahib (Amritsar) and report of the same has been received by this Court, which shows that the statements of the parties have been recorded in view of the compromise and found to be genuine and without any pressure, coercion or undue influence. He further submits that some of the accused have been acquitted.

Looking to the entire matter and nature of the offence namely quarrel etc., I think, the petitioners can be allowed to compound/compromise in relation to the Criminal Complaint No.23 dated

27.01.2009, registered under Sections 323, 379, 452, 427, 504, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar (Rural), particularly when the statements have been recorded by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Baba Bakala Sahib (Amritsar). Hence, the following order is passed:-

ORDER

1. CRM-M-3901-2016 is allowed.
2. Criminal Complaint No.23 dated 27.01.2009, registered under Sections 323, 379, 452, 427, 504, 506, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar (Rural), is quashed by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
